Hebrews 10:11-12 Every priest stands day after day ministering and offering the same sacrifices time after time, which can never take away sins. But this man, after offering one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God.

The priest stands. Jesus sits.

Three words summarize the religion of the Old Testament:

Blood Death Sacrifice

Hebrews 10:12 "But this man, after offering one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God.

- 1. Jesus Christ has done in his death what the Old Testament priests could never do.
- 2. Nothing can be added to the work of Christ because it is final and complete.
- 3. Because his work is finished, our guilt can be removed.

"Who is a God like you, who pardons sin and forgives transgression?" (Micah 7:18).
