- 1. Don't worry about tomorrow because God is already there.
- 2. God promises to be with you no matter what happens to you.
- 3. God has you on his heart at this very moment.

Hebrews 13:5 - He has said, "I will <u>never</u> leave you <u>nor</u> will I forsake you".

It's as if God is saying, "I will never, never, never, never leave you or forsake you. Absolutely not!"

1: Jacob the Cheater

Genesis 28:15 I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go. I will bring you back to this land, for I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you.

2: Israel the Terrified

Deuteronomy 31:6 Be strong and courageous; don't be terrified or afraid of them. For the Lord your God is the one who will go with you; he will not leave you or abandon you.

3: Joshua the Fearful

Joshua 1:5 No one will be able to stand against you as long as you live. I will be with you, just as I was with Moses. I will not leave you or abandon you.

Pastor: God is good.

Congregation: All the time. Pastor: And all the time. Congregation: God is good.

All: 'I am a witness."

4: Solomon the Timid

1 Chronicles 28:20: Be strong and courageous, and do the work. Don't be afraid or discouraged, for the <u>Lord God, my God</u>, is with you. <u>He won't leave you or abandon you</u> until all the work for the service of the Lord's house is finished.

What should we take away from all this?

- > If like Jacob, you are guilty, take heart. God will never leave you.
- > If like Israel, you are terrified, take heart. God will never leave you.
- > If like Joshua, you feel unqualified, take heart. God will never leave you.
- > If like Solomon, you are timid, take heart. God will never leave you.
